## **Add This Guide To Your Phone**

#### **How to Add to Your Phone**



When you first access this guidebook on your phone you'll notice a prompt to add it to your home screen. **This is highly recommended.** It's faster, easier to access, and available if you're ever offline without reception.

Following the prompt will add an app icon to your phone. It's just like any other app, but without you needing to download anything or sign in!

## **Having Trouble Adding to Your Phone?**

You should see a pop up prompt on your phone when you first load the guide, whether that's from an email or a text you've received.

Should you run into any difficulties then there's a handy little help guide that the developers of this Touch Stay software have prepared. You can read it by right clicking this link.

## Don't See a Prompt to Add?

Sometimes the prompt to add the app to your phone won't appear. This is usually due to a phone setting. But there's a way around that!

If you open the link from your email, some phones are set to use the email browser rather than a regular browser like Chrome. In those cases the add to home screen option doesn't work (although the guide itself still works perfectly fine).

This isn't something we can control since it's down to the individual phone settings. **However**, to try and address the issue, you'll notice a pop up message encouraging you to copy the link and paste it in your normal web browser. This will then reveal the add to home screen.

## **Directions**

## Directions by car, bus & train



The easiest way to navigate is to click or tap "MAP" on the bar right at the bottom of your screen. Once on the map you will see the blue home icon. This is where you are staying. Simply click it and then click "get directions". It will open Google Maps and the end point (our address) will be filled in. You simply need to type in your starting point.

In case your tech fails - here's some good old-fashioned instructions:

## **Entering Cheddar from:**

The M5:

If you are towing a caravan or driving a large motorhome via the M5, please exit the motorway at junction 22, not 21 and avoid a stressful end to your journey!

Following brown tourist signs, pick up the A371 heading for Cheddar/Wells. Staying on the A371, ignore signs for the Gorge and drive through the centre of Cheddar village. You'll pass Tesco on your right and the Bath Arms on your left. Continue on this road passing St Andrew's Church followed by Cheddar Football Club on your right. After a further 250 yards, take a right turn (by the Woodpecker Services sign) off the A371 into Labourham Way. Take an immediate left, slow to walking pace and you'll see our large sign in front of you – simply take a sharp left in front of the stone wall and follow the track into the carpark and park up. Pop into reception and say hello and we'll book you in and show you to your pitch.

#### **Bristol A38:**

Proceed through the traffic lights at Churchill staying on the A38. Immediately after the Texaco garage turn left signed Shipham/Cheddar. Continue through Shipham and on towards Cheddar. At the bottom of the hill turn in front of the BP station onto the A371 towards Wells. Drive through the centre of Cheddar village. You'll pass Tesco on your right and the Bath Arms on your left. Continue on this road passing St Andrew's Church followed by Cheddar Football Club on your right. After a further 250 yards, take a right turn (by the Woodpecker Services sign) off the A371 into Labourham Way. Take an immediate left, slow to walking pace and you'll see our large sign in front of you – simply take a sharp left in front of the stone wall and follow the track into the carpark and park up. Pop into reception and say hello and we'll book you in and show you to your pitch.

#### Via the B3135:

If you are towing a caravan or driving a large motorhome via the B3135, please do not turn left signposted Gliding Club, rather continue down the Gorge and avoid a stressful end to your journey and your brake pads! Continue over the mini-roundabout and follow the road until you come to a large stone monument. Turn left onto the A371 signposted Wells. Continue on this road passing St Andrew's Church followed by Cheddar Football Club on your right. After a further 250 yards, take a right turn (by the Woodpecker Services sign) off the A371 into Labourham Way. Take an immediate left, slow to walking pace and you'll see our large sign in front of you – simply take a

sharp left in front of the stone wall and follow the track into the carpark and park up. Pop into reception and say hello and we'll book you in and show you to your pitch.

#### Via the A371 from Wells:

Travel along the A371 through Draycott. You will pass the Cheddar Garden Centre followed by a nasty S bend. On exiting the bend, take an immediate left off the A371 at the "Welcome to Cheddar" sign into Labourham Way then another immediate left, slow to walking pace and you'll see our large sign in front of you – simply take a sharp left in front of the stone wall and follow the track into the carpark and park up. Pop into reception and say hello and we'll book you in and show you to your pitch.

#### Via the B3151 from Wedmore:

DO NOT follow your satnav's instructions to turn right into Labourham Drove unless you are in a 4x4. Instead follow signs for Cheddar Village and turn next right into Station road. At the war memorial turn right onto the A371 signed for Wells. You'll pass Tesco on your right and the Bath Arms on your left. Continue on this road passing St Andrew's Church followed by Cheddar Football Club on your right. After a further 250 yards, take a right turn (by the Woodpecker Services sign) off the A371 into Labourham Way. Take an immediate left, slow to walking pace and you'll see our large sign in front of you – simply take a sharp left in front of the stone wall and follow the track into the carpark and park up. Pop into reception and say hello and we'll book you in and show you to your pitch.

Have a safe journey and we look forward to welcoming you here very soon.

# So what happens upon arrival?

#### **Check-in Time**

To allow easy arrivals and departures, our arrival times are as follows:

2PM if you're bringing your own accommodation

4PM if you're using ours

Final arrival time is 8pm so if you are delayed please call us on 01934 257055 as we restrict on-site driving after dark and may need to pitch you adjacent to our car park until morning.

#### Check-in - how it works

Please drive slowly through our main entrance and likely join a small queue of fellow campers into our Reception car park.

We'd appreciate it if then just one person comes to the desk to check in, we'll then show you all to your pitch and explain key things you'll need to know.

On busy weekends we may ask you to park additional cars in our car park.

#### **Pitching**

We all prefer good neighbours so it's really important that we make sure you're alongside others wanting a similar break to you.

We'll have already put some thought into this (especially if you're in a group) but during check-in we'll make sure we've got it right and then take you to your pitch.

We also want to keep you safe so we'll ask you to make sure that you're accommodation is 6M away from anyone else's although your vehicle can pop into that gap.

## A little about each one

## **Shepherds Huts**

Stylishly hand-built locally in the Mendip hills and totally unique, our huts are kitted out with either two or four double mattresses, full bedding and electric points for the mod-cons – just make yourselves right at home!

#### **Hut Spec**

Made from natural and reclaimed timber and measuring  $3.5m \times 5.5m$  (11.5ft  $\times$  18.0ft). they're insulated with sheep's-wool to keep you warm and toasty and have electric points top and bottom.

What's provided?

Inside you'll find a kettle, fridge and heater. Outside there's a table to all sit around and parking for your vehicle.

All cooking is done outdoors so you'll need to bring your own stove, pots/pans, plates, mugs & cutlery.

Please don't bring a disposable barbecue but If you'd like to bring a gazebo, there's no extra charge

How does sleeping work?

- Peter Rabbit sleeps four people on two super king mattresses.
- Jeremy Fisher and Jemimah Puddleduck sleeps eight on four 4'6 mattresses – two up, two down - you can slide them together or keep them apart – whatever works for you!

#### **Gypsy Bowtops**

Built locally these three wonderful creations are sited in their own field tucked away from the main campsite so you can have a little slice of Somerset all to your own and experience a little of what Romany life must be like.

#### Bowtops spec:

These gypsy caravans are 15ft long so longer than traditional horse drawn wagons. Each interior is decorated differently – check out all three when you go to book.

There's storage situated on each side of the bow top Coat cupboard and a table that seats four. In the kitchen area you'll find a small worktop, kettle, heater and shelving – sorry no cooking inside. There are power and USB charging points.

All cooking is done outdoors so you'll need to bring your own stove, pots/ pans, plates & cutlery but we do provide a table with seating. Please don't bring a disposable barbecue but If you'd like to bring a gazebo, there's no extra charge

Want to put your head down?

Each one sleeps 4 people - two up, two down on comfy double mattresses

#### **Powered Bell tents**

If you've got all the stuff but would rather we took care of the canvas, a powered bell-tent is the way to go! There's loads of room so if the weather's yucky you can all pack inside and play board games in the dry! Just grab your bed, bedding and whoever you like to spend time with and come on down!

Each tent is 6M diameter and sleeps 8 people – sorry no hairy friends. Now remember, we provide the tent but you'll need to bring whatever you like to lie on and sleep under so don't leave home without them! Electric hook-up is provided for those essential items you cannot be without!

# **WiFi Access**

#### **WiFi Access**

Sorry but we've chosen to invest in great toilets, showers and pot wash rather than Wi-Fi.

We have good 4G here and 5G is just around the corner.

If you have a work related need for connectivity, please pop to reception and we'll happily help you out.

# **Phone Reception**

## **4G Reception**

There is a good 4G signal for all networks.

However, we really do suggest you add this app to your phone because not everywhere in the surrounding area has a good 4G signal. If you do lose connectivity then you'll be able to access the content if you've added the app to your phone.

Just note that, if you do travel around the area and lose connection. since it's loading content offline, you obviously won't be able to click external links, use the map, etc since they would require an internet connection. But all the text and photos will work A-OK!

# **Campfires and BBQs**

## **Campfires - hows it work?**

Well we pretty much take care of it all for you! All you have to do is throw it all together and light it :) If you're not sure how, just ask us to show you.

We deliver everything you need right to your door every evening and starting at 5pm we aim to do that by 7.30pm. If you need more logs after 8pm please collect them from Reception.

We provide a fire-kit consisting of:

- Fire-drum £2
- Kindling £4
- Logs £6
- Paper FOC
- Fire-lighter £1

We'll also have on board:

- Marshmallows £1.50
- Sticks FOC
- Matches FOC
- Grills -f5

We accept Card or Cash.

Do's and Dont's

Please do:

- Position your fire 4 m away from your tent further if its windy
- Ask us to help you if you're not sure how to get your fire going
- Bring your own fire-pit if you prefer just so long as it doesn't burn our grass

#### Please don't:

- Bring/burn your own timber we have a planning condition to comply with
- Pile logs above the rim of the drum it will topple over
- Add foraged timber it will smoke and cause us problems with neighbours
- Use disposable barbecues we will remove them if found

## **Barbeques**

Prefer to use your own barbecue? No problem!

So long as its off the ground and doesn't burn our grass just crack on!

Disposable foil barbecues are not allowed on or off the grass

#### Use our fire drum

Most folk simply use charcoal in our fire-drum along with a grill to cook on - you can happily cater for 6 like this.

You can use your own charcoal and grill or ours

#### **Hire an Oil Drum BBQ**

We have a limited number of large barbecues with a cooking surface of 400  $\times$  900 mm so ideal for larger numbers.

So we have a great coffee shack on site where you can make sure you get your caffeine hit! We are open Friday - Sunday (April - Sept) and every morning and evening in the school holidays.

We also sell tea, hot chocs, iced coffee, iced tea and milkshakes!

#### **Info Tent**

You can however charge items in the Info tent - FOC and there's lots of leaflets on local attractions and days out.

We have a small shop in Reception and sell the essentials. Drinks, snacks, toiletries and a few other bits and bobs!

We do not have the facility to freeze ice blocks, but we do sell ice!

#### **Waste and Recycling**
